# Previous Sunday Fixed Route Service

- Prior to the Fall of 2017,
   Stratford Transit did not operate on Sundays.
- At that time a Sunday 1
  hour service was
  introduced



# Previous Sunday Fixed Route Service

- 6 routes were serviced with 3 buses from 10am-6pm (1 hour service).
- Ridership never caught on and remained low for the 2 plus years it was operating. Staff started to explore other service delivery options.
- ODT introduced July 5, 2020.




# Previous Saturday Fixed Route Service

- 6 routes with a 30 minute service.
   Hours of operation was 6am-8pm
- Ridership steady at approximately 50% of weekday ridership until global pandemic in March 2020.
- 85% less ridership and ODT introduced on Saturdays on February 6, 2021 as a response to Covid 19.



## **Fixed Route System Map**





Due to Transit ridership at an all time low due to the pandemic, Stratford Transit began a responsive, responsible approach to save operating costs while at the same time continuing to offer Customer's an enhanced, positive ridership experience. With using an "on demand" platform you simply request a trip between any two bus stops in the city on Saturdays between the hours of 6am to 8pm and Sundays between the hours 10am to 5:30pm, and a transit vehicle will take you there transfer free while servicing other riders.

#### FAQ

#### DO I NEED TO USE THE APPS?

No, you can use your transit agency's rider web portal. Log into the web portal at ridestratford.ca to book your trip.

#### CAN I BOOK A TRIP FOR MYSELF AND OTHERS WHO ARE WITH ME?

Yes. When booking a ride, indicate the amount of riders travelling with you. When boarding, the person who booked the trip wil be confirmed by the driver, who will see the count of your party.

#### CAN I BOOK TRIPS AHEAD OF TIME?

Yes! You can book trips either "ASAP" (as soon as possible), or in advance.

#### WHEN WILL I KNOW MY ETA?

A few hours before your trip is supposed to take place. The current/dashboard screen on your app will update with a message that reads "Coming Soon" as well as an estimated time of arrival.

#### IMPROVING SERVICE

Stratford Transit will move to a Saturday/ Sunday On-Demand Service to allow our service to meet the current customer needs while routing buses only to the requested stops. Customers will be able to schedule a ride based on their timeframes and desired stops, allowing passengers to go anywhere in the city between 6 am to 8 pm (as of February, 6) on Saturdays and Sundays between 10 am to 5:30 pm.


While you can book your trips either "ASAP" (as soon as possible), or in advance we recognize sometimes plans may change. You can cancel anytime through the app.

#### HOW TO SIGN UP

- 1 Download the App on the iOS app store or the Android Play store, or access the web portal at ridestratford.ca
- **2** If using the app, enter **Strafford** as the transit code when first opening the app. This will connect it to Stratford Transit.
- **3** Press sign up, review the terms and conditions, enter your **e-mail and a password**, then select sign up.
- 4 Check your email inbox, including spam folder, for a confirmation e-mail. Select the link in the e-mail.
- **5** Enter your e-mail and password in the app and login.



#### REQUEST A RIDE


- Press New Ride.
- 2 Select your pickup and dropoff stops, the number of people riding with you, and the time of your ride. Time can be set to pickup or drop off time.
- 3 Press Add Ride to confirm.

**TIP:** You can book your trip in **advance**, or select **ASAP** to book the trip for right now.



#### MONITOR YOUR RIDE


- After requesting a ride, you will be assigned to a vehicle.
- 2 As your vehicle approaches, your current screen/dashboard will give you an estimated time of arrival.
- **3** Once your vehicle arrives, the driver will confirm your boarding.




#### **NEED TO CANCEL?**

Cancel anytime. Navigate to the main menu of your app and select Rides. Find the ride you want to cancel and swipe it to the right, then press cancel.








#### **Stratford ODT Report Card**

Stratford's ODT service has been running on Sundays since July 2020, and launchedon Saturdays in February 2021. How has that service been going since then?


#### **Average Wait Time:**

The average wait time is calculated based on requested pick up time and a 15-minute pick up window allowed. As an example, if a 5pm pick up is requested, the bus will show up between 5pm and 5:15pm.

#### **Fuel Cost Savings:**

Daily fuel cost savings between old, fixed route service and ODT is: Saturday- \$613.62 Sunday- \$ 75.87







Early only means a bus arrived early but waited for Customer to arrive prior to departing

Tolerance, as mentioned previously is the 15-minute pick up time window









This map shows vehicle movement throughout the service area; higher elevation represents a greater concentration of GPS pings collected from vehicles, representing locations where they spend more time or visit more frequently.



## **Recent Transit Funding**

To be noted, the MTO has recognized and included an additional eligible expenditure in the guidelines (SRA-Phase 3) which allows Transit Agencies to claim up to 50% of Capital costs for Micro/Macro Transit (On Demand) due to numerous Transit Agencies implementing this service as a response to low ridership levels.
